## 6324 Abbreviated instruction



Actual appearance may differ from the illustration.The crown has two positions when pulling it out.

## Setting the time

1. Pull the crown out to position 2 when the second hand points 0 second.

The second hand stops.

- 2. Rotate the crown to set the time.
  - Move the hands 4 or 5 minutes forward and move them back to the right time to set the time more precisely.
- **3.** Push the crown in to position **O** in accordance with a reliable time source.

The second hand starts moving.

## Setting the moon phase indication

- **1.** Pull the crown out to position 1.
- **2.** Rotate the crown clockwise to set the moon phase.
  - Refer to a newspaper or other source to see actual moon phase.
  - Use the indicated moon phase only as a reference.
  - Appearance of the indication may differ in some models.
  - The moon phase can be set more accurately when it is new or full moon.
