(-) , (?)	<i>any</i>



Are there any books in the box? – Yes, there are.



There is an apple on the plate.



There isn't an apple in the vase.



There is some milk in the bottle.



Is there an apple in the bag? – Yes, there is.



There isn't any milk in the glass.



Is there any milk in the cup? – No, there isn't.



There are some books on the table.



There aren't any books on the chair.
