# Arc de Triomphe

## L'Arc de Triomphe

### Arco del Triunfo

Think of Paris and the Arc de Triomphe will spring to mind as one of its most significant commemorative monuments. The beautiful neoclassical arch was ordered in 1806 by Napoleon and designed by the architect Jean Chalgrin to honor those who fought and died for France in the French Revolution and Napoleonic Wars. Since then, it has been the rallying point of French troops parading after successful military campaigns and the site of the annual Bastille Day Parade.

Lorsque l'on pense à Paris, l'Arc de Triomphe est l'un des plus importants monuments commémoratifs qui nous viennent à l'esprit. La superbe arche néoclassique, commandée en 1806 par Napoléon et conçue par l'architecte Jean Chalgrin, commémore le souvenir des soldats morts au combat pour leur pays durant la Révolution française et les guerres napoléoniennes. Depuis, la structure a servi de point de ralliement à la parade des troupes françaises célébrant le succès des campagnes militaires et au défilé annuel de la fête nationale.

Es imposible pensar en París y no recordar el Arco del Triunfo: uno de sus monumentos conmemorativos más importantes. El precioso arco neoclásico fue encargado por Napoleón en 1806 y diseñado por el arquitecto Jean Chalgrin en honor a aquellos que lucharon y murieron por Francia durante la Revolución

francesa y las guerras napoleónicas. Desde entonces, se ha convertido en punto de paso imprescindible para las tropas francesas al desfilar luego de campañas militares exitosas, así como en el centro del desfile anual del Día de la Bastilla.





# Champs-Élysées

## Les Champs-Élysées

### Campos Elíseos

One of the world's most beautiful and famous boulevards, the Champs-Élysées is synonymous with all that is glamorous and grand about Paris; luxury shops, cafes and theaters. Running almost 1.25 miles (2 kilometers) through the 8th arrondissement, it initially was an extension of the Tuilleries Gardens leading to the palace at Versailles, opened by Louis XIV in 1667, a date that many consider to be the birth of Paris as a grand city.

L'un des boulevards les plus beaux et les plus célèbres au monde, les Champs-Élysées sont synonymes de tout le prestige et le faste de Paris : boutiques de luxe, cafés et théâtres. Traversant le 8<sup>e</sup> arrondissement sur près de deux kilomètres, l'avenue était à l'origine une extension du jardin des Tuileries menant au Palais de Versailles, ouvert en 1667 par Louis XIV. Beaucoup considèrent cette date comme le début de Paris à titre de grande ville.

Uno de los bulevares más hermosos y populares del mundo, el de los Campos Elíseos es sinónimo de todo lo que es glamoroso y grandioso en París: tiendas de lujo, cafeterías y teatros. Con una longitud de casi 2 km a través del VIII distrito, comenzó siendo una prolongación del jardín de las Tullerías que conducía al Palacio de Versailles y fue inaugurado por Luis XIV en 1667, año que muchos consideran el del nacimiento de París como gran ciudad.





# Tour Montparnasse

## La tour Montparnasse

## Torre Montparnasse

This 688.9 ft. (210m) monolithic skyscraper is located in the Montparnasse area of Paris. Designed by the architects Eugène Beaudouin, Urbain Cassan, and Louis de Hoÿm de Marien, it was built by Campenon Bernard. It was the tallest tower until 2011 when the Tour First surpassed it. Loved and hated, it is often criticized for being out of place in the Paris skyline but offers unique panoramic views of the city's famous attractions.

Ce gratte-ciel monolithique de 210 mètres de hauteur s'élève dans le quartier du Montparnasse de Paris. Œuvre des architectes Eugène Beaudouin, Urbain Cassan et Louis de Hoÿm de Marien, la structure a été construite par Campenon Bernard. Il s'agissait de la plus haute tour jusqu'à ce que la tour First se hisse au premier rang en 2011. À la fois aimé et détesté, cet ouvrage est souvent sujet à critique pour être mal assorti à la silhouette de Paris, mais offre une vue panoramique sans pareille sur les attractions populaires de la ville.

Este monolítico rascacielos de 210 m se encuentra en el área de París conocida como Montparnasse. Diseñado por los arquitectos Eugène Beaudouin, Urbain Cassan y Louis de Hoÿm de Marien, la construcción es obra de Campenon Bernard. Fue la torre más alta hasta 2011, cuando la Torre First la superó. Amada por unos y odiada por otros, es criticada con frecuencia por parecer fuera de lugar en el horizonte de París, aunque ofrece unas extraordinarias vistas panorámicas de las atracciones más populares de la ciudad.



## Grand Palais Le Grand Palais

The Grand Palais des Champs-Élysées was built in 1897 in preparation for the Universal Exposition of 1900 and is now a historical site, exhibition hall and museum complex. Its original purpose was to be the home of great artistic events in the city of Paris. Since its inauguration, this ornate building with its spectacular glass roof has seen a parade of art and cultural shows of all types.

Le Grand Palais des Champs-Élysées, bâti en 1897 en prévision de l'Exposition universelle de 1900, est maintenant un lieu historique, une salle d'exposition et un complexe muséal. Son objectif initial était d'être le berceau de grands événements artistiques dans la ville de Paris. Depuis son inauguration, ce bâtiment orné d'une verrière spectaculaire a été le théâtre d'expositions artistiques et culturelles en tout genre.

El Grand Palais des Champs-Élysées fue construido en 1897 con motivo de la Exposición Universal de 1900 y hoy comparte funciones como monumento histórico, sala de exposiciones y complejo museístico. Fue concebido como un espacio para organizar los grandes eventos artísticos de la ciudad de París. Desde su inauguración, este bellísimo edificio y su espectacular techo de vidrio han visto desfilar muestras de arte y cultura de todo tipo.



# Eiffel Tower

## La tour Eiffel

## Torre Eiffel

Nothing represents Paris more than the iconic Tour Eiffel, or Eiffel Tower. Built between 1887-1889, it is named after the engineer Gustav Eiffel, who designed and built the wrought iron structure.

The actual design of the tower was by Maurice Koechlin and Émile Nouguier, who worked for Eiffel at the time, together with architect Stephen Sauvestre, and was inspired by the Lattig Observatory in New York.

This much-loved global cultural icon of Paris was not, however, so popular on its inception; it was much maligned by leading artists and intellectuals of the time. Today, however, it is considered to be a magnificent example of structural art.

Il n'existe pas meilleur symbole parisien que l'emblématique tour Eiffel. La structure en fer forgé édiflée entre 1887 et 1889 doit son nom à l'ingénieur Gustave Eiffel, responsable de sa conception et de sa construction.

Inspirés par l'observatoire de Lattig à New York, Maurice Koechlin et Émile Nouguier, qui travaillaient pour M. Eiffel à l'époque, ont dessiné la tour en collaboration avec l'architecte Stephen Sauvestre.

À l'époque de son inauguration, cette icône culturelle mondiale grandement prisée de Paris ne faisait pas tellement l'unanimité auprès des artistes et des intellectuels de renom, qui ne ménageaient pas leurs critiques. De nos jours, cependant, on la considère un magnifique exemple d'art structurel.



Ningún otro monumento representa el espíritu de París como la emblemática Torre Eiffel. Construida entre 1887 y 1889, su nombre rinde homenaje al ingeniero Gustave Eiffel, quien diseñó y construyó la estructura de hierro forjado.

El diseño visible de la torre, inspirado en el Observatorio Lattig de Nueva York, fue obra de Maurice Koechlin y Émile Nouguier, que trabajaban para Eiffel en aquel entonces, en colaboración con el arquitecto Stephen Sauvestre.

Este icono cultural de París, hoy de fama internacional, no fue tan popular en sus principios, cuando debió enfrentar las muchas críticas de importantes artistas e intelectuales de la época. Hoy, sin embargo, es ampliamente considerado un majestuoso ejemplo de arte estructural.

# The Louvre

## Musée du Louvre

### El Louvre

The Musée du Louvre opened in 1793, during the French Revolution, and from the very beginning was intended to provide inspiration for contemporary art. As a former royal residence, the Louvre is inextricably linked to eight centuries of French history. Over 35,000 artworks are displayed, including universally admired works such as the Mona Lisa by Leonardo da Vinci, the Winged Victory of Samothrace and the Venus de Milo.

Ouvert en 1793 pendant la Révolution française, le musée du Louvre a, dès ses débuts, eu pour ambition d'être une source d'inspiration pour les artistes contemporains. Ancienne résidence royale, le musée du Louvre est intimement lié à huit siècles d'histoire de France. Plus de 35 000 œuvres d'art y sont exposées, dont des chefs-d'œuvre universellement admirés comme la Joconde de Léonard de Vinci, la Victoire de Samothrace et la Vénus de Milo.

El Museo del Louvre fue inaugurado en 1793, durante la Revolución francesa, y ya en sus comienzos estaba entre sus objetivos servir como fuente de inspiración para el arte contemporáneo. Como la antigua residencia real que es, el Louvre está profundamente unido a ocho siglos de historia francesa. En sus salas se exhiben más de 35.000 obras de arte, algunas de ellas universalmente admiradas, como la Mona Lisa, de Leonardo da Vinci, la Victoria alada de Samotracia o la Venus de Milo.

### The Most Glamorous Cycle Path

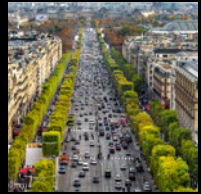
