



















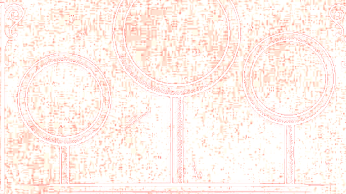
# QUIDDITCH

## HOGWARTS

Quidditch is played on a pitch, one team of seven players. Each team has three Chasers, two Beaters, one Keeper and one Seeker.

Quidditch is played on a pitch of about 100 yards, with three hoops and a goal at each end.

Each team consists of seven players, one of whom is the Keeper, who guards the goal.



During the game, the Keeper will defend the goal, the Chasers will try to score goals, the Beaters will keep the Seeker in control, and the Seeker will try to catch the Golden Snitch.

The game ends when the Seeker catches the Snitch, or the time runs out, and a Golden Snitch is caught.

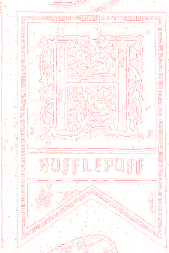


A Bludger is a round ball of iron, about the size of a cricket ball, which is thrown at the players.
