We also decided to introduce a new addition to the LEGO® moths and butterflies collection with the mesmerizingly green Spanish moon moth. You can breathe new life into your garden as you move plants to different locations to suit your mood or let them take turns soaking in the sun or cooling down in the shade. You can even move around larger parts of the model to create different shapes and expressions.

Vous pouvez donner une nouvelle vie à votre jardin en déplaçant les plantes à différents endroits selon votre humeur ou en les laissant s'exposer au soleil ou se rafraîchir à l'ombre à tour de rôle. También decidimos ampliar la colección de polillas y mariposas LEGO® con la hechizante mariposa isabelina, que resalta por su brillante color verde. Puedes dar un soplo de nueva vida a tu jardín moviendo las plantas a diferentes lugares según tu estado de ánimo, o simplemente dejándolas tomar el sol o refrescarse bajo la sombra según los ciclos naturales. Incluso puedes reorganizar secciones más grandes del modelo para crear distintas formas y expresiones.

Perfect for checking the acidity of your fountain!

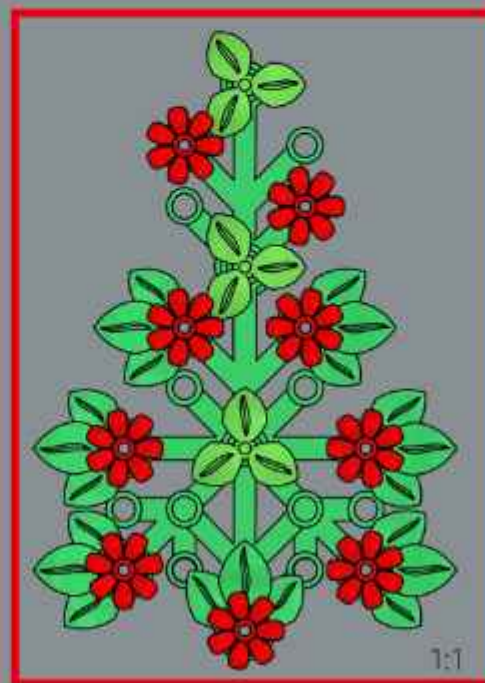

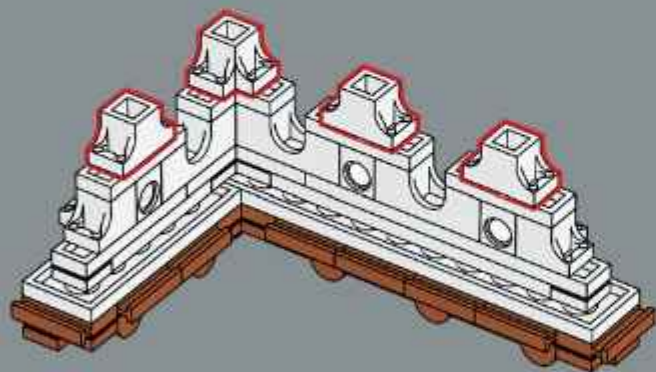


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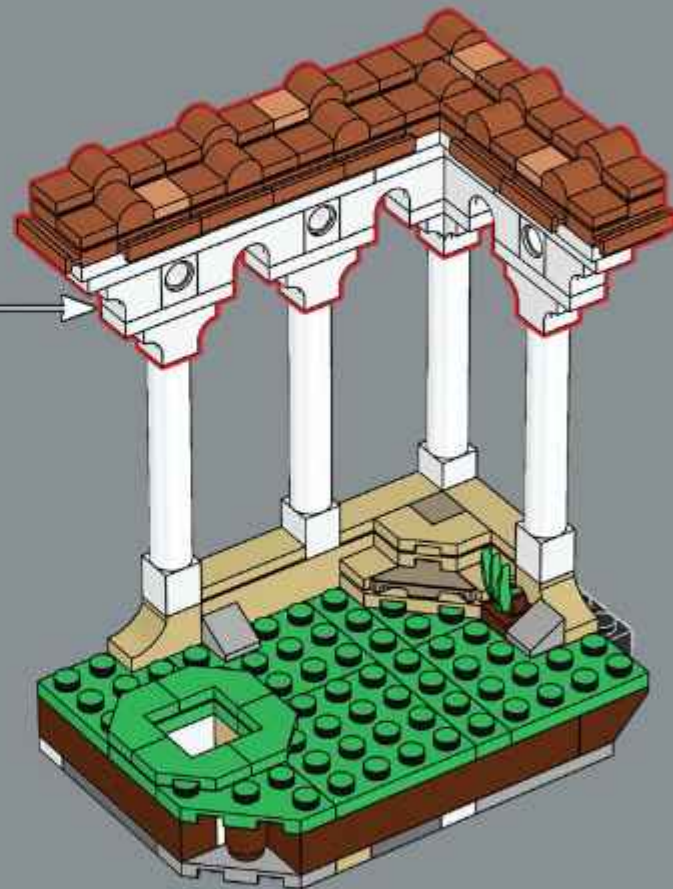




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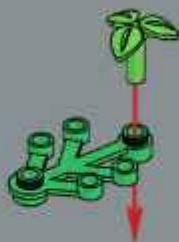


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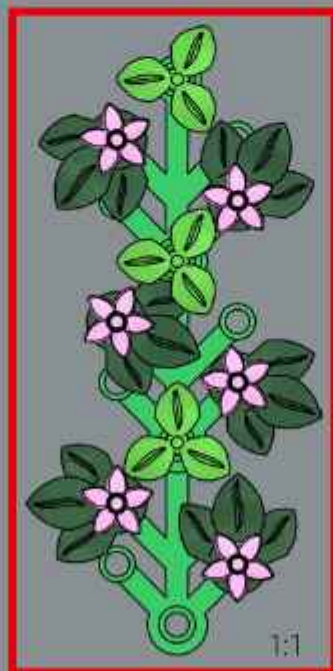
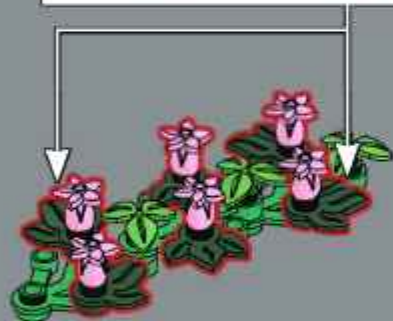
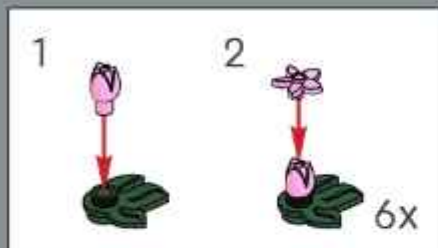


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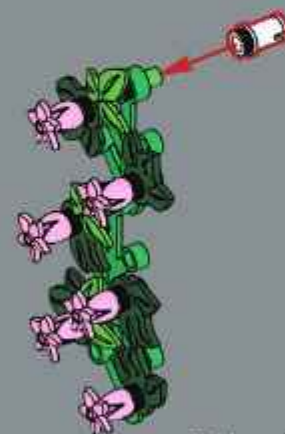




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Pink bougainvillea flower (Bougainvillea)

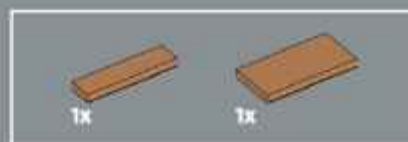
Bougainvillée rose (Bougainvillea)

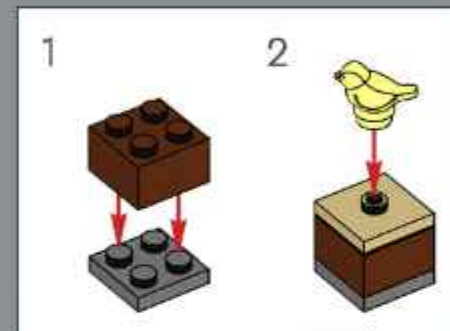




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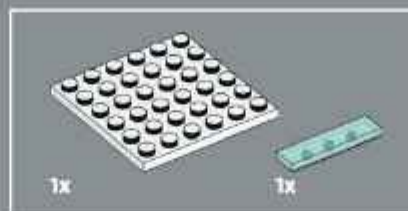


Yellowhammer (Emberiza citrinella)

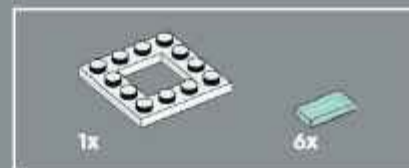
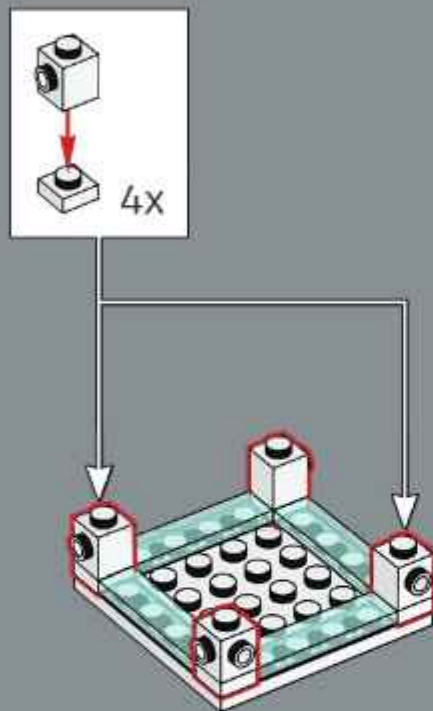


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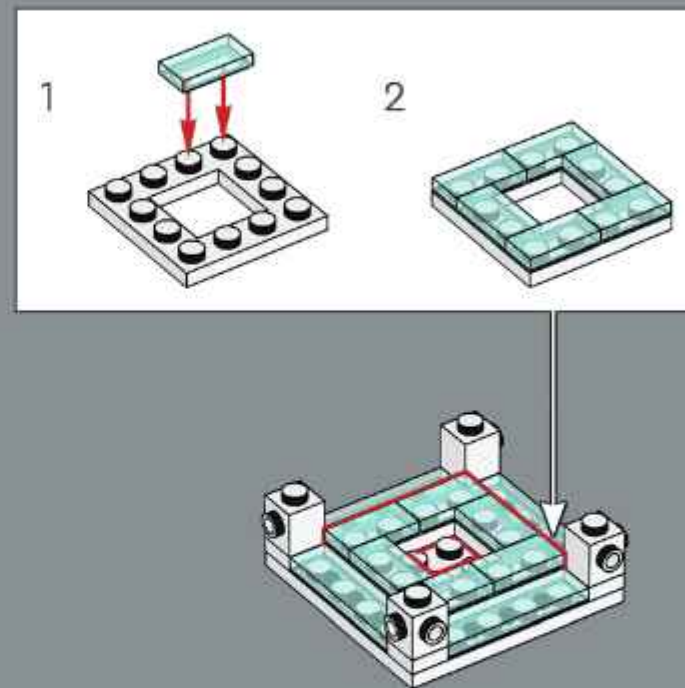




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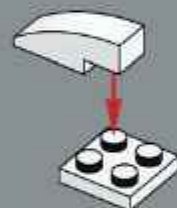
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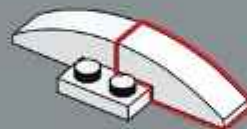


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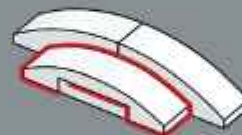
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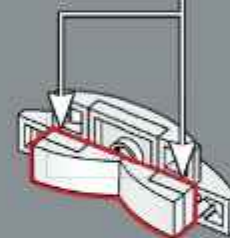
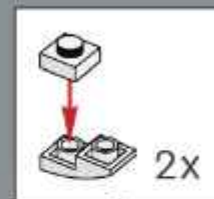
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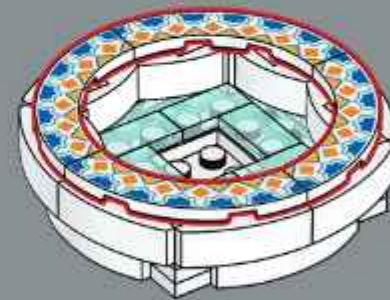
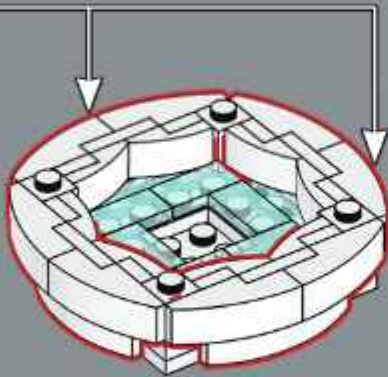
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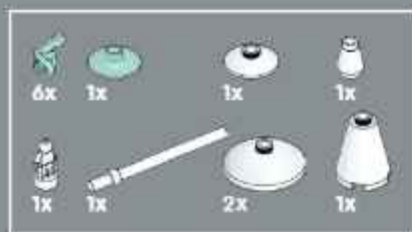


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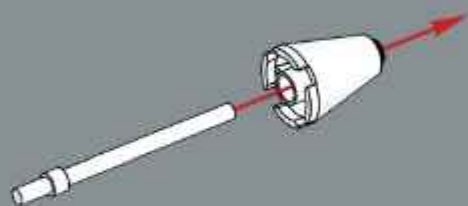
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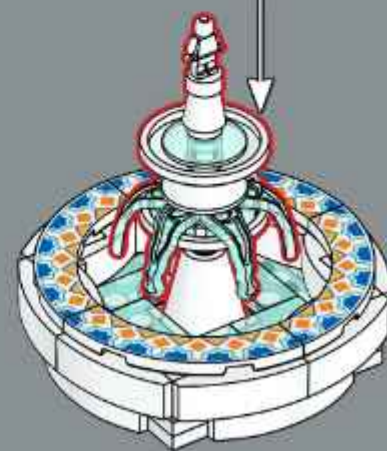
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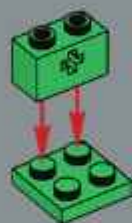
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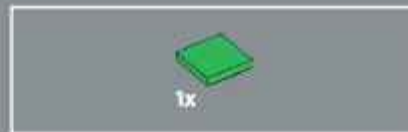




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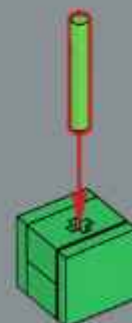
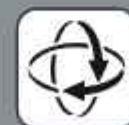
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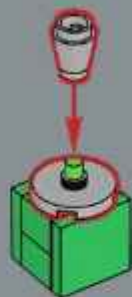


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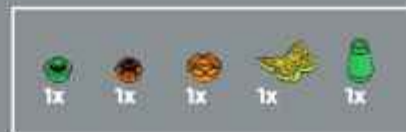
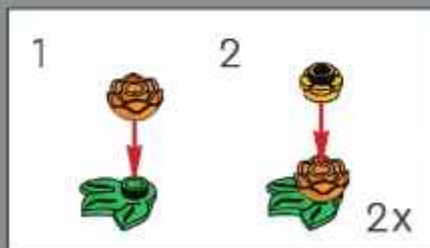
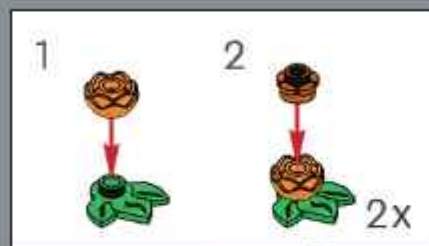


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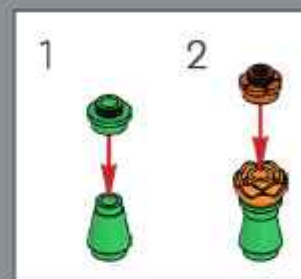




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Spanish moon moth (*Graellsia isabellae*)

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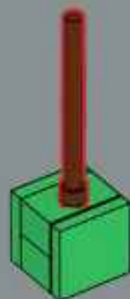




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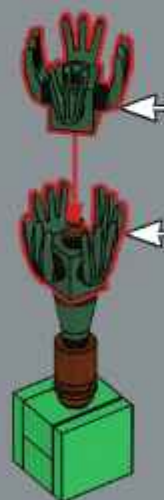
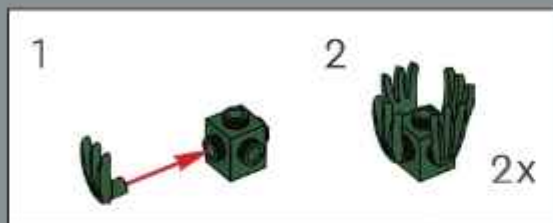


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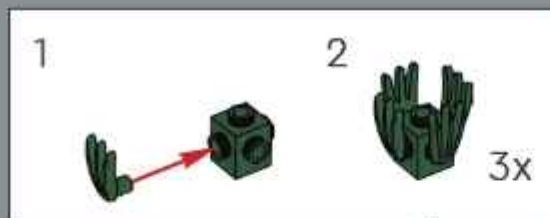


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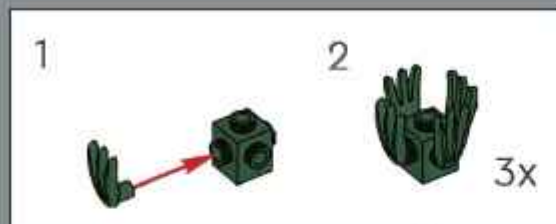


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Mediterranean cypress (*Cupressus sempervirens*)
