Allow yourself to be whisked away to a serene, tranquil garden and please, stay as long as you like. Maybe you feel inspired to nurture your creative roots or cultivate your own little corner of mindful activity and reflection. This is your space. You can breathe new life into your garden as you move plants to different locations to suit your mood or let them take turns soaking in the sun or cooling down in the shade. You can even move around larger parts of the model to create different shapes and expressions.

Tu feliz estancia podría inspirarte para nutrir tus raíces creativas, o incluso animarte a cultivar tu pequeño rincón dedicado a la atención plena y la reflexión. Este es tu espacio. También decidimos ampliar la colección de polillas y mariposas LEGO® con la hechizante mariposa Isabellina, que resalta por su brillante color verde. Puedes dar un soplo de nueva vida a tu jardín moviendo las plantas a diferentes lugares según tu estado de ánimo, o simplemente dejándolas tomar el sol o refrescarse bajo la sombra según los ciclos naturales. Incluso puedes reorganizar secciones más grandes del modelo para crear distintas formas y expresiones.

These decorated pieces created for this set were inspired by the zellige style of mosaic tiling. This style is very prevalent in the architecture of ancient historical sites and monuments in countries such as Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia and the Andalusian region of southern Spain.

These tiles can be used to create patterns that can be repeated into infinity, which is called tessellation. How many different patterns can you create?



Red hibiscus flower (*Hibiscus rosa-sinensis*)


